

Dear Neighbor,

We wanted to update you on our Piedmont Enhancement Project. Our crews are making great progress and we appreciate the community's ongoing patience during this process. This project will help ensure we can meet the growing energy needs in this community and will enhance our ability to meet our customers' need for natural gas on the coldest days of the year.

Construction for the Piedmont Enhancement Project will continue in phases. The project includes the installation of new natural gas mains, a regulator station and the replacement of vintage mains. The project path runs along Piedmont Road from East Pelham Road to Squire Place and from Fountainhead Lane to Peachtree Road. It also includes East Paces Ferry Road from Piedmont Road to Peachtree Road.

Segment 1 Update – Piedmont Road from East Pelham Road to Squire Place

Our crews are currently installing pipe in this segment. The areas disturbed by our project are being temporarily restored as the project team moves northward, with final road restoration occurring after we complete the segment. Segment 1 is nearly halfway complete.

Segment 2 Update – Piedmont Road from Fountainhead Lane to Morosgo Drive

Construction began in this segment in early November. Crews started their work at the Morosgo Drive end and will move southward. Similar to our segments already under construction, notification letters were mailed to property owners prior to the start of our work.

Segment 3 Update – Piedmont Road from Morosgo Drive to Alpine Road

In the coming weeks, our crews will restore the concrete roadway in Segment 3 that was impacted by our work. This work will take several days and involve lane closures for an extended period of time. The closures will allow the concrete to cure and will help ensure the safety of the community and our crews.

Segment 6B Update – East Paces Ferry Road from Peachtree Road to Piedmont Road

Our crews have paused their work in this area for this year. They will return in January to complete their work in this segment.

Work Hours and Holiday Break

Our work hours for the project are determined by the government agency responsible for each individual road. For Segments 1 and 6B, the City of Atlanta's Department of Transportation is allowing us to work Mondays through Fridays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. For the remaining segments, the Georgia Department of Transportation is granting us work hours between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Our crews will take a holiday break the last two weeks of December.
